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BEFORE YOUR SURGERY

- **SURGERY ARRIVAL TIME:** You will receive a call **or** email **1 WEEK BEFORE** your surgery confirming the date, time of arrival and other Pre-op instructions.
- MEDICATION EYE DROPS: Start using your medication eye drops in the operative eye 2 days before surgery - You will receive a phone call from Linda Frayne Pharmacy located in Montreal regarding a *credit card payment in order for your eye drops to be shipped to your home.*

PAYMENT: 1st surgery must be paid on the day of your pre-op measurements. 2nd surgery payment can be made on or before the day of 2nd surgery (Visa, Mastercard, Cash, Debit). We **do not** accept cheques, money orders or AMEX.

Medication Eye Drops Instructions:

| BEFORE SURGERY | 2 days before surgery | 1 drop/ 3 times a day |
| DAY OF SURGERY | Morning of Surgery | 1 drop |

- SHAKE bottle well before using in the OPERATED EYE ONLY
- You CAN use LUBRICATING DROPS and GLAUCOMA DROPS while using these drops
- Wait 1-2 minutes between all other drops

DAY OF SURGERY

Please ensure the following:

- <u>DO NOT EAT OR DRINK</u> after Midnight the night before surgery. This includes no chewing gum, no hard or soft candy, no coffee, no tea, no milk or cream, no soup or broth. Sips of water are allowed only to swallow your morning medications.
- ✓ You <u>MUST</u> Take blood pressure and heart pills
- × <u>DO NOT</u> Take diabetes pills and/or insulin
- You <u>MUST HAVE AN ESCORT/DRIVER</u> to accompany you to the clinic. Your escort MUST be present at the time of registration and it is preferable that they stay NEAR the Surgery Center. Your total time at the clinic will be 1.5 2 hours.

*** FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN CANCELLED OR DELAYED SURGERY*** ***CANCELLATION FEES WILL BE CHARGED***

Other Instructions:

- **BRING ALL** of your eye drops and all regular morning medication
- **WEAR** loose fitting clothes so that monitoring equipment can be applied easily.
- DO NOT WEAR jewelry and do not bring any other valuables.
- o **DO NOT WEAR** contact lenses, face cream, makeup, perfume, hand cream or aftershave.
- **BRING** a valid form of payment (Visa, Mastercard, debit or cash). NO checks, money orders, or AMEX please.
- **WASH YOUR HAIR** prior to your surgery as you will not be able to do so for 3 days.

POST OPERATIVE APPOINTMENTS are scheduled in advance, for you to be seen within 5-7 days after surgery. (An appointment card will be provided to you on the day of your surgery)

AFTER YOUR SURGERY

| DAY OF SURGERY Start when you arrived home and use until bedtime | After surgery until bedtime | 1 drop every 2 hours |
| STARTING DAY AFTER SURGERY | Use drops for 4 weeks | Continue 1 drop/ 3 times a DAY |

The following are commonly experienced after surgery:

- Blurry vision, light sensitivity
- Tender sandy or itchy feeling for <u>hours to several days</u> (Use Lubricating drops to alleviate these symptoms)
- Often the vision clears up slowly
- Everyone heals differently and your two eyes can also heal differently from each other.

Back to Work:

• For office or desk jobs, resume work within 3-5 days. For jobs that require heavy lifting or working in dusty environments, we suggest 1-2 weeks off from work.

You will be given:

- 1. A PLASTIC SHIELD to be worn while sleeping or napping for the first 3 days/nights
- 2. LUBRICATING EYE DROPS use as needed if eyes feel dry, itchy, sandy or irritated
- 3. **SUNGLASSES** to be worn anytime you are outside for 1-2 weeks for protection
